

Human Rights Policy

Our guiding principles are:

- Treat equally all potential employees. The terms and conditions of employment are the same for everyone.
- Treat all guests equally.
- Work in partnership with government agencies to report and handle any incidents violating human rights.
- Train our employees on this policy and ways of identifying and reporting incidents of unfair treatment.

The management sets objectives, targets and actions to achieve and measure the performance of this policy and regularly reviews their progress. In addition, the hotel's management system is used for planning, implementing, measuring and controlling the guiding principles.
